■ 828 million people suffer from chronic hunger worldwide and of these nearly 193 million face acute hunger.

■ Our action in food security is cross-cutting, with a multiplier effect and encompasses several human rights and SDGs, with a commitment to community development, gender equality and the empowerment of women in their communities.



Caritas acts by contributing to food security through:

- 1** Delivering adequate food aid and livelihoods tailored to the needs of the most vulnerable.
- 2** Procurement and distribution of food, quality seeds, livestock, veterinary kits and implementation of mobile veterinary clinics.
- 3** Training on agricultural and cattle-breeding techniques, agro-ecology and agro-ecological gardens.
- 4** Food production, construction of enclosures, peanut processing units and other projects.
- 5** Strengthening the capacities of Caritas sister organizations and the resilience of communities.
