

Right to clean water AND SANITATION



Did you know... ?

- Drought, climate change, conflict and lack of access to drinking water in the Sahel, the Horn of Africa and Haiti expose women, children and their families (often located 2 and 3 km from their home) at increased risk of contracting diseases such as cholera and diarrhea, and at serious risk of sexual violence, kidnapping, trafficking and other abuses.
- In the Horn of Africa, the Sahel and Haiti, the effects of the lack of clean water and sanitation, added to child malnutrition, hunger suffered by pregnant women, elder people and people with disabilities, are a real and avoidable threat to the lives of millions of people.

Cáritas acts by contributing to access to clean water and sanitation by means of:

- 1 Construction, rehabilitation and maintenance of structures for access to drinking water and water use (wells, small dams...)
- 2 Acquisition and distribution of latrines, irrigation pumps, water purifiers
- 3 Strengthen the capacities and organizational structures of the communities
- 4 Training of community committees in water management and infrastructure maintenance
