

# Humanitarian emergencies and **FORGOTTEN CRISES**



## Did you know... ?

- The humanitarian emergency in the Sahel and the Horn of Africa particularly affects the most vulnerable people in rural, subsistence farming areas, who have been forced to abandon their homes, crops and herds due to violence.
- Most of those forced to flee their homes are taking refuge in host homes and communities where solidarity prevails, but causing severe pressure on scarce food resources, clean water and other basic services such as education and health.
- The war in Ukraine has worsened forecasts for food availability and access in areas such as the Sahel, a region of high cereal imports.
- The number of people in need of food assistance has reached 3 million across the Sahel and West Africa and more than 36 million in the Horn of Africa.

## Caritas is active in contributing to humanitarian emergencies through:

- 1 Humanitarian assistance in food security and livelihoods for displaced populations.
- 2 Improving and addressing the basic humanitarian needs of the most vulnerable host families/communities to enable them to recover from the conflict.
- 3 Campaigns to support humanitarian emergencies caused by catastrophes and natural disasters.
- 4 Visibilising and supporting forgotten crises.
